- 2.1. **6:30 p.m. Public Hearing – Finance:** Hold a public hearing on a tax rate of \$0.436351 per \$100 valuation that has been proposed for adoption by the governing body of the City of Bronte. This rate exceeds the effective rate, and state law requires that two public hearings be held by the governing body before adopting the proposed tax rate.
- 2.2. **Ordinance 1st Reading – Finance:** Consider an ordinance levying ad valorem taxes for use and support of the municipal government of the City of Bronte for 2017; providing for apportioning each levy for specific purposes; and providing when taxes shall become due and when same shall become delinquent if not paid.
