Mayor Gohman presented FY2026 Fiscal Year Operating Budget for review. The mayor resented the council with two budgets; one with a 3% salary increase and one with a 5% salary increase. The council reviewed both and went with the budget of 5% salary increase.

There is a proposal that we put all the money into CD's, and we are working that out. I need to budget to be final before we can work on a budget CD(s).

Mayor Gohman will address turning cash in funds into budget CDs at the next budget workshop.

David Scott would like to mark where the pavilion will be in the Cemetery, so we don't sell any plots there.

David Scott asked if there was any way to get water on the community golf course. Ricky Royall answered yes.
