Elections

Qualifications for the Office of Mayor:

- Be a United States citizen;
- Be 18 years of age or older upon the commencement of the term to be filled at the election;
- Resided continuously in the State of Texas for 12 months, as of the deadline for filing for the office;
- Resided within the city limits of Bronte for at least the 12 months preceding the election day;
- Have a current voter registration certificate;
- o Not have been convicted of a felony from which the person has not been pardoned or otherwise released from the resulting disabilities;
- Not have been deemed mentally incompetent by a final judgment of a court; and
- Not otherwise disqualified from serving on the city council by any other provision of law

Qualifications for the Office of Councilmember:

- Be a United States citizen;
- Be 18 years of age or older upon the commencement of the term to be filled at the election;
- Resided continuously in the State of Texas for 12 months, as of the deadline for filing for the office;
- Resided within the city limits of Bronte for at least six (6) months preceding the deadline for filing for office;
- Have a current voter registration certificate;
- Not have been convicted of a felony from which the person has not been pardoned or otherwise released from the resulting disabilities;
- o Not have been deemed mentally incompetent by a final judgment of a court; and
- O Not otherwise disqualified from serving on the city council by any other provision of law.
