AN ORDINANCE MAKING APPROPRIATIONS FOR THE SUPPORT OF THE CITY OF BRONTE FOR THE FISCAL YEAR BEGINNING OCTOBER 1, 2022 AND ENDING SEPTEMBER 30, 2023; AND ADOPTING THE ANNUAL BUDGET OF THE CITY OF BRONTE FOR THE 2022 FISCAL YEAR.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BRONTE:

SECTION 1: That the appropriations for the fiscal year beginning October 1, 2022, and ending September 30, 2023, for the support of the general government of the City of Bronte, Texas, be fixed and determined for said terms in accordance with the expenditures shown in the City's fiscal year 2022-2023 budget, a copy of which is appended hereto as Exhibit A.

<u>SECTION</u> 2: That the budget, as shown in words and figures in Exhibit A is hereby approved in all respects and adopted as the City's budget for the fiscal year beginning October 1, 2022 and ending September 30, 2023.
