ORDINANCE NO. 25-07 FEE SCHEDULE ORDINANCE

AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY OF BRONTE, TEXAS; REPEALING AND REPLACING ORDINANCE 23-11, DATE OCTOBER 26, 2023; REPEALING AND REPLACING ANY FEES DESCRIBED IN ANY ORDINANCE PREVIOUSLY ADOPTED BY THE CITY COUNCIL; ESTABLISHING A GENERAL FEE SCHEDULE FOR THE CITY OF BRONTE; AMENDING SECTION III SANITATION, SECTION FIVE WATER; AND ESTABLISHING AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BRONTE, TEXAS:

- I. <u>Repeal.</u> All ordinances and ordinance provisions in conflict with the provisions of this Ordinance shall be, and the same are, hereby repealed, and all other provisions not in conflict with the provisions of this Ordinance shall remain in full force and effect.
- II. <u>Enactment.</u> This Ordinance No. 25-07 shall be the Fee Schedule Ordinance of the City of Bronte and shall establish all fees approved and adopted by the City Council of Bronte, Texas and established by Ordinance.

The unpaid bill must be paid in full before services can be turned on along with security / utility deposit is as follows:

The City reserves the right to require payment of all unpaid utility bills and any other outstanding debt owed to the City prior to the time that such connection is made.

(h) <u>Disconnect Fees:</u>

- 1. Disconnect Fee for non-payment for services: \$55.00 each occurrence in a 12-month period.
- 2. More than two (2) Disconnections for non-payment: \$75.00 each occurrence in a 12-month period.

(When the number of disconnect actions to less than two (2) in a 12-month period, the charge shall return to \$55 for each occurrence).

(i) <u>Illegal Use Reconnect or Damage Fees:</u>

- 1. A pulled meter by the City for unauthorized use of water shall collect \$55.00 before a meter will be reinstalled.
- 2. Damaged meters, fitting, boxes, valves, and/or appurtenances installed by the City shall disconnect the water service, remove the meter or appurtenances thereto and assess actual repair charges based on FEMA equipment rates to the utility customer, plus a damage fee of \$55.00.
- (j) Water bills are due on or before the tenth (10) day of each month (the "due date"). If payment of any bill is not made by the due date, the city may add a late charge of 10% of the unpaid bills, charges, and expenses.

(k) The City shall have the right to and may terminate water service at any time if the customer's water bill has not been paid by 8:00 am on the 26th day of the month following the due date.

Registration issued shall be valid for one (1) year. The fee for registering dogs and cats will be a one-time fee to register any new pet, older than 3 months old, but proof of rabies vaccination is required yearly. Exemptions to Registration fees are detailed in the Animal Ordinance.

(b) Impoundment Fee Dogs & Cats:

- 1. Unrestrained without vaccination tag or license attached:
 - (A) 1st Offense: \$35.00 initial fee + \$7.00 per day thereafter
 (B) 2nd Offense: \$50.00 initial fee + \$7.00 per day thereafter
- 2. Unrestrained with vaccination tag or license attached:
 - (A) 1 st Offense: \$25.00 initial fee + \$7.00 per day thereafter
 (B) 2nd Offense: \$40.00 initial fee + \$7.00 per day thereafter
 - (C) Any Offense may also incur municipal court fines to be determined by the Court.

- (c) <u>Impoundment Fee Livestock:</u> Each occurrence is a \$75.00 initial fee + Coke County impoundment fees.
- (d) Nonindigenous Snakes:
 - 1. City Registration Fee:

\$5.00

- III. <u>Open Meetings.</u> It is hereby officially found and determined that the meeting at which this ordinance is passed was open to the public as required and that public notice of the time, place, and purpose of said meeting was given as required by the Open Meetings Act, Chapter 551, Texas Local Government Code.
- IV. <u>Effective Date.</u> This ordinance shall take effect upon approval by the City Council and after publication as required by the Texas Local Government Code.
