  - Consider hiring a full or part-time EDC person
  - Community development needed to provide a “sense of place”
  - FDBC San Antonio consultation for help
  - Implement a program retreat for community development members


Discussed On-going Street Beautification. Expected to hear back Wednesday from TxDot with update. Discussed awnings.
